5) General Manager's Report:

a) Hurricane Hanna Update - Erosion repair options

General Manager reported damage repair options due to extensive erosion during Hurricane Hanna. HCID#6 Engineer presented two repair options to Board Members. Option (1) to repair damaged pipe caused by the erosion, and Option (2) replace with new overflow structure. This will be placed as an agenda item on next month's meeting with cost estimates.

b) Expansion Project 2022 - Update

HCID#6 Engineer informed Board Members of the detailed information provided in the application for Expansion Project 2022 on behalf of HCID#6, including monitoring facilities, canal relining for better efficiency, and expansion to the North. He emphasized the main purpose for the application submittal is for HCID#6 to become a part of Region M.

c) HCID#6 Surplus District Property Protocol Draft

General Manager presented Board Members with a possible real estate protocol for HCID#6 to follow in the event a landowner is interested of purchasing the District's property. Legal counsel recommended General Manager to bring back to Board for review and discussion.

d) Emergency Action Plan Annual Revision

General Manager informed Board Members of the Emergency Action Plan that TCEQ requires to be reviewed annually. He will be meeting with Legal Counsel to bring back to Board for further discussion.

e) Substation update

General Manager reported to Board Members a vendor quote of \$1,137.50 for fence material only. Mr. Holbrook agreed to take care of installing fence and labor costs.
